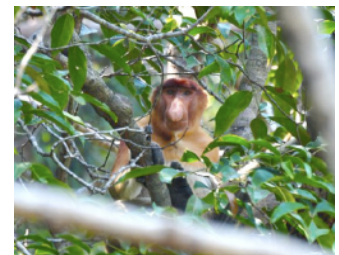


Options include: selecting your hotel ranging from boutique hotels, to 3-4-5 Star
selecting the amount of time to stay at the longhouse,
selecting from several longhouse experiences

Day 1: ARRIVAL & PICK-UP AT KUCHING AIRPORT
transfer to selected hotel for check in and overnight.

Day 2: KUCHING - BAKO NATIONAL PARK (B, L, D)
Overnight at the park chalet.

Day 3: BAKO NATIONAL PARK - KUCHING. (B, L)
Return to Kuching mid-afternoon. (Schedule may depend on tide).
Overnight at your hotel.



Day 4: KUCHING – ORANGUTAN CENTER-MENYANG TAIS LONGHOUSE. (B, L, D)
(Pick-up approx. 8:15AM Depart by air-conditioned van for Semengoh Orangutan Reserve to see semi-wild orangutans during their morning feeding time. Depart the center and continue on to Batang Ai reservoir. Journey over-land (4-5 hours) through rural Sarawak, passing through pepper gardens, cocoa and rubber plantations. At the jetty take a longboat to the longhouse. Meet the residents and have dinner. Overnight in the longhouse.



Day 5: MENYANG TAIS LONGHOUSE. (B, L, D)
Overnight at the longhouse. Visit the village farms and enjoy a traditional BBQ while searching for orangutans in the wild.
Day 6: MENYANG TAIS LONGHOUSE – KUCHING. (B, L)
Proceed to Kuching and drop off at your hotel.



Day 7: DEPARTURE. (B)
Transfer to Kuching airport for departure flight

WHAT TO WEAR

(A complete list of tips for clothing, packing & getting around Kuching personalized by Jungle Jaunts will be supplied upon full payment of bill.)

The climate in this part of the world is tropical, thus it is hot and humid. Wear clothes which are light and dry easily. You may find, however, that buildings such as hotels, shopping centres and government offices are cold due to the air-conditioning.

In these cases, you may wish to have a pullover. In the town areas, dressing is casual but one should use some common sense to gauge what is acceptable. As with most places, a good rule of thumb is to observe what the local people wear and follow accordingly.

Basically nothing too tight, short, or revealing is fine.

The tropical days are hot and humid and we recommend light, comfortable cotton shirts.

Casual wear is acceptable for most occasions in the city; on trips to the interior, shorts and T-shirts may be more appropriate.

For most trips, bring swimming gear to slake off the tropical heat. But please remember to respect local modesty. Light rain wear is a must as invariably there will be encounters with rain. (An inexpensive plastic parka-type coverup is perfect). This should be carried with you folded up & accessible at all times, as you may need it on short notice)

Be prepared to get wet and have lots of fun as you explore this mystical island and discover for yourself a whole new world.
